FYEG stands for education for the general population to reduce dated views about indigenous populations based on ignorance and prejudice, and a recognition of their economic and social rights to continue their ways of life. This should include local self-determination on issues such as mining and reindeer herding as well as promotion of cultural works in indigenous languages. We support efforts to ensure that these rights are harmonised across artificial political borders, such as through international conventions.
