Introduction

Hello everybody!

I am Antonio G. González, I am an activist of Juventud Verde (Spanish Young Greens) and FYEG. I currently live in my hometown in Tenerife / Canary Islands, although for a long time I have lived in Madrid. In the capital of Spain, I studied my double degree in sociology and international relations, but it is also the city that has seen me grow and take my steps as a political activist. My activism covers many fields but especially LGBTIQ, feminism, social justice, and climate change. This has led me to specialize in both gender and political communication. Due to the covid pandemic, I moved back to my hometown in the north of Tenerife, an area characterized by a mix of rural and urban. This change of life made me focus on my physical, mental and relational health. With this, I have developed activism from the

importance of the bases, renewal, and care. Both experiences converge in this FYEG EC candidacy to put welfare, diversity, and just transition policies from a youth perspective at the center of European policy.

As Angela Davis said: "You have to act as if it were possible to radically transform the world. And you have to do it all the time".

Motivation - Vision - CV - Support Letters

Motivation Letter

A person's life is measured by the experiences and sometimes the goals that we acquire, but all this is not possible without taking into account the steps we take throughout our careers, our activism or our life. It was 2017, and a young and inexperienced Antonio was beginning to take his first steps by joining the Red EQUO Joven, the current Juventud Verde (JV) and the Young Greens of Spain. Before that new adventure that would bring them here, they started working for Spain and Europe with Social Justice, Diversity and a Just Ecological Transition. Since April 2017, Antonio has continued his work until today and will continue it by running for the FYEG Executive Commission.

With this short introduction, I want to show my experience, motivation and desire to work to build a fairer, diverse and greener Europe. But first of all, I would like to present my roots and the circumstances that have brought me to this point. I was born and raised in the Canary Islands, a mid-Atlantic archipelago off the coast of Africa. The Canary Islands are characterized by being the most populated outermost region of the EU, but also by being a diverse and precarious region due to its economic sources. I grow up in the north of Tenerife, an area where the rural and the urban intermingle, where social rights are a constant struggle and our history and culture go through migration to Latin America, Africa or Europe. At the age of 18, I moved to Madrid, the mainland, where I studied for my university degree and started my activism and my professional career which was cut short by the covid-19 pandemic. This made me return to live with my mother in the Canary Islands and continue everything from a distance. This has brought me closer to the reality of my community and how oppressions, violence and international economic structures also operate and perpetuate themselves even on small islands in the Atlantic.

I think this is the best time to take a step forward. For the past five years, I have worked from Juventud Verde to create a structured and forwardlooking organization, creating robust foundations and structures that will assist the generational renewal of the entity.

For four years (2017-2021) I have been part of the Executive Committee of Juventud Verde along with exceptional people who have helped in the transformation of the organization. We have consolidated JV as the voice of the Spanish environmentalist youth before the FYEG, we have strengthened its role before the regional youth councils of Spain and before the Youth Council of Spain (CJE); we have also strengthened the voice and presence of the youth before the mother party, demonstrating that we are the present and the future of the party; in addition to strengthening statutes that concern the reality of youth, and three permanent workspaces (Ecofeminism, Communication and Political Action). But all this has been thanks to the work done as a team, which is necessary for the day-to-day work of a youth organization.

In addition, during the last five years, I have participated in several FYEG activities as a local organizer (FYEG General Assembly 2017 in Madrid or the beginning of the 2019 European Elections Campaign "Be Brave, Green Europe"), and also as a JV representative to FYEG in spaces such as the South MOs group, FYEG General Assemblies and Mo Forums held in the last five years. I have also participated in the group of young candidates during the 2019 European elections and as a candidate for a local institution.

This complete introduction to my experience within the green youth spaces of both JV and FYEG would not be possible without the work previously done in other spaces such as NGOs, university associations or LGBTIQ+ associations.

In addition to my experience in the professional field in the NGO sector. To this, we must also add my knowledge acquired through a double degree in Sociology and International Relations, a postgraduate degree in development, and several courses in political communication, big data, migration and international relations. Also thanks to the fact that through my academic, activist and work experience I have specialized in gender, the LGBTIQ+ collective and social rights, in addition to acquiring knowledge in migration and environment and climate change.

My candidacy to the EC has as its main objective to bring my experience and my work to FYEG, in addition to giving the opportunity to new activists as this great organization has done in the past with me. I also think it is important to emphasize that my motivation is to work on FYEG's candidacy for the European elections together with the European Green Party, promoting the candidacies of young people, dissidents and social minorities.

I would also like to base my work on four fundamental axes, (1) to promote the importance of rural and island areas of Europe, which are often isolated from European policies; (2) to fight for a Europe where security is not only a militaristic concept and association with war but a concept associated with the freedom to live without violence; (3) to create youth policies that take into account the economic and social reality of all sectors that make up society; and (4) to create a care policy within FYEG that takes into account the needs of both members of elected bodies and FYEG workers as well as members of the international teams of each MO from north to south, from east to west.

For years I have collaborated with FYEG as an activist, sometimes in events, sometimes in meetings or working groups, but I think it is time to take a step forward and work for all young people in Europe for a sustainable, socially just and diverse future. A step for all.

Vision on FYEG

The Federation of Young European Greens is an example of the progress and welfare of young people in Europe and the world. Step by step it has built a diverse organization that stands for the values of unity and the defence of human rights and the struggle for a just transition and social justice in Europe. FYEG is open and welcoming, from the moment I started participating they have opened their arms and spaces to me, something very important in a youth organization in such a complex geographical area.

The vision I have for FYEG is to continue the previous work that has been done by both the outgoing EC and the FYEG technical office, in addition to all my colleagues from the MOs and former members of the previous ECs. My mandate within the EC would be to improve step by step the work and objectives of the organization. This requires an analysis of the general needs of both the MOs as grassroots organizations and those who build the FYEG, as well as taking into account the working people of the technical staff of the FYEG office. The welfare of all and care policies must be a reality in the FYEG, this is a political space of convergence but that does not mean that care is left aside. Care is one of the great feminist bases of the organization.

Well-being and safety, both in the absence of violence, are one of the three pillars of my vision for FYEG. Working for social justice both inside and outside the organization, for young women in Europe and all over the world, a social justice that is also global.

The diversity and plurality of social realities is an innate characteristic of FYEG, but that does not mean that it is all done. We have to continue working for the organization to remain plural and diverse. For this, the opening of the working groups to people who are not only part of the MOs and who share our values can be a tool to expand the number of activists within the FYEG. Also, the continuous work in all areas of FYEG to realize the needs of the different social groups is something basic in the work of an organization.

Finally the policies of FYEG, and also as a tool of nexus with the institutions of the European Union and the Council of Europe, in addition to the EGP, it is necessary to take into account all those territories that are not big cities; these are the island territories, largely dependent on the continent in day to day activities, such as rural areas that have been seen as an alternative and basic axis of life in all countries of Europe, and that burden a low development because the resources have always been intended for large cities and wealthy regions.

These three pillars of my thinking and vision of the future of FYEG will constitute part of my work within FYEG in addition to the necessary work that will have to be done and that the mandate of the GA will give to the colleagues of the new EC. Also, it a necessary to work to prepare for the European elections of 2024 in addition to supporting the young women candidates running for the various elections during this period.

Finally, I would also add the strengthening of relations with green organizations in countries and continents where we have more relations such as the Maghreb, Latin America and Africa. In addition to the continuity of the work with the European institutions, the impact on the EGP as in the European Youth Forum.

Current affairs are always a pressing issue, the war in Ukraine, energy dependence on Russia; the economic crises generated by the pandemic of covid-19 and the war in Ukraine, even the vestiges of the 2008 crisis; the attack on the rule of law is violated in several countries in Europe; social and civil liberties are also in question; And of course, the great threat of youth, climate change; all these issues must be intersectional with the work of the people who form the EC of the FYEG since a work without taking into account the social and current reality would be invalidated by not reaching the needs of the population.

Finally, I think it is important that in this moment of political instability in which youth are the present and the future of democracy and freedoms, we need to be able to motivate ourselves in those small steps we take every day here is a poem by the Spanish poet Miguel Hernandez.


