MOTIVATION LETTER

DEAR GREEN FRIENDS,

I am very excited to run for FYEG's Executive Committee and with this letter, I want to give you some insight into my motivation!

Getting involved in Green youth politics proved surprisingly difficult for me. I was born and raised in Germany but left the country when I was 18 (I am 25 now and still haven't gone back - currently I am based in Brussels). Moving around a lot and oftentimes not speaking the local language well enough to get involved (sorry ik spreek geen nederlands), I started searching for a way to get involved anyway - and found FYEG!

I first became active in FYEG in 2017 when I joined the Working Group 'Future of Europe'. I remember my first FYEG event and how amazing it was to find myself surrounded by people who shared my values, and ideas, and were equally enthusiastic about the same issues. The following year I again became engaged in a Working Group ('Welcoming and Inclusive Europe'), this time as a coordinator. In 2020, I was elected to the Political Platform Committee and, together with an amazing team, drafted the new Political Platform, focusing especially on the topics of feminism and LGBTQI+ rights, democracy, and international affairs. Last year, I joined the FYEG Office as a communications intern and got to know the organisation from yet another side, learning a lot about FYEG structures in the process. Currently, I am a member of the Ecosprinter Editorial Board, the FYEG-affiliated magazine for young Greens from all across Europe.

FYEG is my political home, a place where I have grown a lot, both politically and personally. I have learnt so much over the last few years, especially thanks to the many incredible people I have met through the organisation. Today, I am running for the EC because I want to contribute to the task of taking FYEG forward. I am excited for what's to come, and I want to actively take part in shaping FYEG's next steps into the future.

Through my many years of involvement with FYEG in a variety of roles, I know the organisation very well, know how it works, and know its strengths but also its weaknesses. Especially through my work on the Political Platform, but also through my personal experiences in different countries and my work, I have become keenly aware of the different political contexts FYEG MOs are facing, in which they are struggling with very different problems. It is pretty amazing that FYEG brings together so many young people from all over Europe, who are all, while coming from so different circumstances, fighting for the same values and ideas.

I do think I have the experience and the skills necessary to make a valuable contribution to the next EC's work. I have a good work ethic and am well organised, having learnt how to manage my time and my work in an effective manner while making sure I do not burn out. I work well in a team and care very much about being reliable, communicating clearly if there are problems, but also, simply showing empathy and understanding for each other when things get difficult. But maybe most important for my application, I am incredibly enthusiastic to build on the amazing work done by past ECs and to shape the future of FYEG!

MY VISION FOR FYEG

The idea of FYEG's future is not something envisioned by any single person, but rather something that is developed through the collaboration of many different people. The following points are the issues I want to highlight and focus on should I get elected to the Executive Committee, while being very much aware of the fact that there are many other areas in which FYEG can grow and which also deserve our attention.

BUIDLING NETWORKS, INSIDE AND OUT

Looking at the state of our world out there, it is very easy to lose hope. The battle for a better world can sometimes seem pointless. Thankfully, we are not fighting it alone. FYEG has much to gain in building bridges and networks, playing the role of a connector, both inwards and outwards.

Internally, FYEG is in the ideal position to bring together MOs that are facing similar struggles and could learn a lot from each other's experiences. Those can be political struggles, but also organisational ones - how to build structures and how to work effectively as an organisation. The MO-to-MO-trainings are an excellent example of how this can work in practice, and an idea we should develop and build on further. FYEG should also focus on facilitating exchange and connecting individual activists with each other. Over the past years, the exact role that FYEG Working Groups play has sometimes been unclear and the number of Working Groups has shrunk. Meanwhile, it is important to provide opportunities for activists to get involved in FYEG on an individual basis with a very low threshold. Whether through loose networks, more formalized working groups or other formats, it is an important task for FYEG to connect individual activists with each other while following a clear strategy in doing so.

Looking outwards, FYEG should build connections with actors that are working towards the same goals and where those connections exist, strengthen them. This of course includes, but does not stop with other actors within the Green family. In some issue areas, our political goals overlap with those of other political youth organisations, and we can achieve more by working together. This does not only include the youth wings of other European political parties but also other initiatives that are working towards causes like racial justice and worker's rights. Especially in areas where we ourselves can become more inclusive (e.g. is FYEG an overwhelmingly white organisation), we can learn from initiatives that are working on issue areas in which we still need to grow. Finally, climate activist movements, especially youth movements, are of course sharing many of our goals, with many FYEG activists being also active in the climate movement. Here, it must be our task to support and highlight where we can, but never to overshadow, focus attention on ourselves or claim something that is not ours, always being mindful of what our place is, and what it is not.

A TRULY FEMINIST FEDERATION

One of the most impactful memories I made during my very first FYEG event was the experience of being in a truly feminist space. FYEG is a proudly feminist organisation that has done a lot of work in the past to make sure it offers spaces that are safe and inclusive. However, building a truly feminist organisation in a patriarchal world is a never-ending struggle. Being a leftist, activist space is unfortunately not an automatic safeguard against sexism and misogyny. If we want to live up to our ideals, we need to continuously prioritize making FYEG a feminist, inclusive organisation.

It includes looking at our projects and checking who we are reaching with them, and if necessary, making changes. It includes using our events to empower and work on issues that target specifically marginalized groups. For example, a lot of young women who are politically active, both in and outside of party politics, experience enormous amounts of online harassment and abuse, aimed at making them withdraw from the political space. How do we make sure we protect and provide a safe space for our own activists?

It also includes the topics we choose to focus on in our advocacy work. We are currently witnessing disturbing, ever-worsening attacks on women's and LGBTQI+ rights. The individuals and organisations driving these attacks work together internationally. Here, FYEG is ideally situated to work on a response that likewise goes beyond borders.

UNITED TOWARDS 2024

As young Greens, we share a vision of the world we want to build. If my work on the Political Platform has shown me one thing, it is that there is remarkable unity amongst MOs when it comes to the vast majority of political positions. That does not mean that we agree on everything. Different geographies, different histories, and different political realities result in us disagreeing on some issues. Now, I have admittedly not come up with a scientific way of measuring (dis)agreement, but my personal rough estimate is, that FYEG MOs can fully agree on around 90% of our political positions.

This leaves us with 10% of issues that we approach from very different perspectives, and on which we sometimes simply disagree. And that's completely fine. We do not need to agree on everything, in fact, no democratic movement ever does.

In 2024, the next European elections will take place, and one major task of the next Executive Committee will be to keep the family together and make sure we go into this election year united. That does not mean finding a common position on everything. What we need to do is find ways to manage our differences and build understanding and respect for each other through exchange and dialogue. Meanwhile, we must not lose sight of the importance of working together and of the many many things we agree on. At the end of the day, there is much more that unites us than what divides us.


