MOTIVATION LETTER - MARIE STADTLER

Dear Federation of Young European Members,

As dedicated members of the Green movement, we are all working to strengthen our fight against climate change and social injustice and our commitment to mitigate the capitalistic workings in our societies. The Federation of Young European Greens has been and will always play a big part in bringing each of our organisations together and take us to the unique position we are in as the Greens - an international movement.

I am running for the position of treasurer as I believe with my experiences and skills, I will bring a new perspective to the role and continue the work that the office and previous treasurers have already done. In my opinion this approach is crucial as FYEG grows as an organisation each year which increases the importance of budgeting and a good overview of the finances.

My journey as a political activist is guided by my passion for international cooperation and cultural understanding. Growing up in Germany and now living in Scotland for the last seven years, with periods of time living, studying and working in Brussels, Pamplona and Passau, my life has been an international one.

My time as a Green activist starts with my tenure as International Officer for the Scottish Young Greens. Since July 2020, I am in charge of the international outreach of SYG, being the main contact person for FYEG and its member organisations. In my time in this role, I managed to increase the visibility of FYEG in my own organisation, make international and European politics interesting for my members and organised three big projects.

As the lead organiser for the international webinar series and workshop “A Just Transition for Scotland – Lessons from Europe”, I managed the prep team whilst also being the contact person for the four European organisations we work with. We worked together with the Irish Young Greens, Grön Ungdom, Gronn Ungdom and the Young Greens of England and Wales.

MOTIVATION LETTER- MARIE STADTLER

In September 2021, I organised the week-long, 35 person Summer Camp “Taytos & Tatties: A Celtic Reunion” in the Scottish Highlands for the Scottish Young Greens in cooperation with the Irish Young Greens. As this camp was funded by FYEG, the European Youth Foundation of the Council of Europe and the Greens/EFA Group in the European Parliament, I managed a budget of around 15.000 Euros.

As the lead organiser for all SYG projects I was responsible for the budgets which gave me the experience to oversee smaller project finances in a Green organisation.

Through my involvement in FYEG as the International Officer, I had the opportunity to work as an intern for FYEG and the Greens/EFA Group in 2021 which gave me insight of how FYEG works from a different perspective. Back in Scotland, I worked for the European Greens, Green European Foundation and Scottish Green Party organising the Green Hub at COP26 in Glasgow. Through this work, I was able to get to know the Green partner organisations, strengthen my organisational skills and deepen my knowledge of the Green movement in Europe and beyond.

I am now working as the Fundraising & Events Officer for the Scottish Green Party, combining my expertise in event and project management with the skills of a fundraiser. I am organising the national fundraising strategy and supporting local branches with their fundraising efforts in the run-up to the Scottish elections.

Being elected to become the treasurer for FYEG would be a great opportunity to continue my international work and journey, using the skills and experiences I have gathered in my roles in Scotland and Europe. Being part of FYEG has been shaping me to a great degree, by becoming the treasurer and a member of the Executive Committee I would look forward to bringing in my passion and expertise to this important organisation.

Dear Federation of Young European Members,

The Federation of Young European Greens is growing and as an organisation we need to adapt to this change. It is amazing that we are expanding with more EU member organisations and even beyond those EU borders. I believe the treasurer will need to take an active role in the next year to set out a progressive budget and work on a fundraising strategy. If elected, these will be my priorities in the role of treasurer:

Fundraising

As the Fundraising & Events Officer of the Scottish Green Party, I want to use my experience and expertise to write and implement a fundraising strategy for the next five years. It is important that FYEG establishes fundraising as a normal activity in the organisation to further our ability to support member organisations and run campaigns. With my fundraising strategy, I want to encourage the set-up of a regular giving campaign, gaining another stream of income to support FYEG's work.

If elected, I want to work with the office staff to set out tangible goals and test different fundraising formats in the elected period. I believe in learning from other similar organisations and would work with the European Greens and Tilt to understand what works best for European Green organisations and what will be a challenge.

Merchandise is also a great way to fundraise for an organisation, therefore I want to continue the work of previous ECs and offer merch to members and individuals.

Budget setting "After Covid"

Covid has shaken up the way we work, do campaigns and organise projects. Therefore, I believe that we also need to consider these situations in the way we set FYEG's budget.

If elected as treasurer, I want to explore the possibilities to make smaller project grants available for member organisations. Organisations that do not have a budget themselves or do not have the capacities to organise a full project from the usual grants, should still have the opportunity to organise a small campaign or event with FYEG's support.

Additionally, I want to work with the office staff to explore more funds and grants for FYEG as an organisation itself.

Treasurer as Executive Committee member

Being elected treasurer also means being part of the Executive Committee, therefore if elected I have priorities that go beyond the budget, fundraising and finances.

Coming from a small organisation with limited capacity and budget, I want to support these kinds of smaller member organisations with their internal organisation and projects. The MO-to-MO trainings have been a great way to start this support. I want build on this basis and further train member organisations and their own members, building capacity and expertise.

In addition, as an EU citizen coming from an organisation that is based in a non-EU country, I know how challenging it can be to inform and excite my own members about the campaigns and policies FYEG is working on. If elected, I believe FYEG should explore and provide a space for non-EU member organisations to discuss policies and campaigns. Through this policy forum, all member organisations can stay informed about current events, ask questions and signpost their own members to international affairs that might be of interest.

I believe in FYEG's potential to be the connection for Green organisations in Europe to come together, work on common policies and be the Green and Youth voice in the fight against climate change, social injustice and the growing disparity in the world. If elected, I want to make the treasurer position into a more active role, seeing the potential to guide FYEG to become an even better organisation, supporting its own member organisations and further our cause and influence in the political world.


