Motion text

From line 67 to 70:

- Environmental and climate policies must be subjected to rigorous scrutiny by an academically diverse, independent authority to identify their potentially regressive impacts. We must avoid at all costs that the poorest, and disproportionately people of colour already exploited by the capitalist economy, are disproportionately impacted by these policies.

From line 72 to 74:

- the effects of environmental inequalities and to support the poorest. Environmental and climate policies should not be a burden for poor ~~people;~~ people and people of colour; they must be designed so as to benefit them.

Reason

The resolution mentions intersectionality, but then proceeds to ignore (or at least not mention) the fact that environmental inequality that affects the poor disproportionately affects people of colour.
