Motivation Letter

My main role within SYG was in organising the Youth Hub for COP26 which was hosted in Glasgow last November. Working alongside FYEG and GYG (Global Young Greens) we hosted 19 sessions over 12 days for young activists from across the globe; focusing on climate justice, youth in politics and fossil fuel divestment. 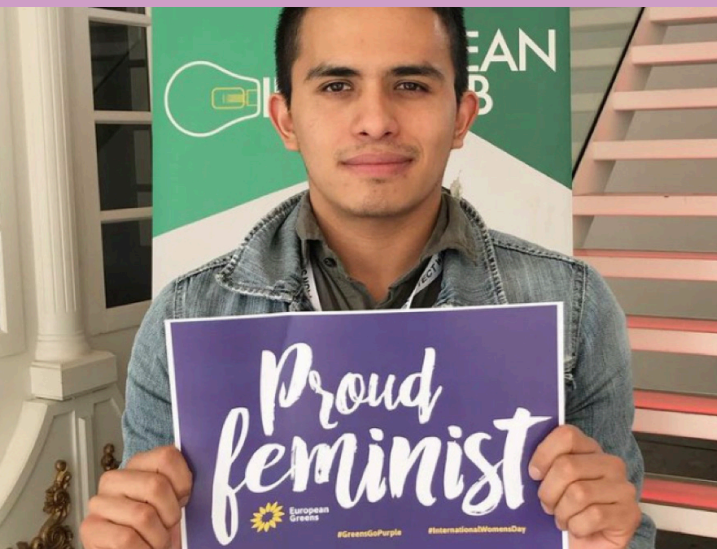
I'm a proudly Latino migrant, queer,

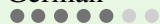

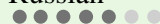
