Introduction

Srishagon (Srish) Abraham, 22, is a law student, an activist, a dreamer, a doer, a fighter, a lover, a young green. Originally from Malaysia, he was forcefully conscious from a young age of the systematic and systemic racism and discrimination against his fellow Indians in Malaysia, and later of refugees and irregular migrants. Witnessing first-hand what it means to be voiceless – even silenced – and the cruciality of being heard in a society, he has made it his mission in life, conscious of his own privilege, to give a voice to the voiceless and a platform for them to be heard.

His fervent prioritisation of the representation and inclusion of minority cultural and ethnic groups in politics only but continued since moving to Europe in 2019. He immediately continued his activism and political involvement upon moving in DWARS and the LGBTQIA+ student association of Amsterdam. And now he wants to take that a step further in FYEG, making the young green movement truly a movement for all.

Dear Secretary General Kara,

Brevity being the soul of wit, I will keep this as concise as possible. Putting my candidacy for board member of the EC forward is with one core vision in mind: solidarity. As a dedicated ambitious candidate with a record to back it up, I believe I would be a pragmatic addition to the EC – where platitudes are met with concrete action.

Pragmatism and ambition are not mutually exclusive, they're Ying and Yang – ambition drives one to strive for their dreams, pragmatism grounds one in reality. Growing up in Malaysia, I was always forcefully conscious of the fewer rights I had as a racial minority, let alone the lack of rights altogether as a sexual minority. It is this consciousness that drove me to make it my mission in life to empower, support and fight for the marginalised and disenfranchised – to give the voiceless a voice, because everyone deserves to be heard. Solidarity. It is this ambition in which I was the youngest finalist at 16, representing Malaysia at the UNICEF High Level Meeting on Child Rights; in which I volunteered to help undocumented Rohingya refugees; in which I led an initiative to tutor less fortunate Indian children; in which I have always stood up for the rights of my fellow Indians in Malaysia.

And it is this ambition that drives me to continue that fight no matter where I am. Moving to the Netherlands three years ago, I created the position of board member of International Affairs at DWARS Amsterdam, built a framework for internationally-oriented development and organised several events and workshops with experts and MEPs on European solidarity, activism and migration law. In the LGBTQIA+ student association of Amsterdam, I started the 'Dear White People' initiative to give queer POC members a platform, and founded and chaired the diversity working group to hold the board accountable and develop policies centred to the diversity, inclusivity, and intersectionality of all queer people. As international secretary of DWARS, I am working on various initiatives to ensure youth for whom Dutch is not their mother tongue are just as included in our green and left movement; as well as initiatives to ensure the continuity of DWARS in European and international representation.

Therefore, it is simply not enough to me to voice out solidarity, it must be actualised and manifested; it is, to me, threefold: not just with the (international) community, but with each other and within the board. Solidarity with each other entails ensuring every organisation of the Federation has an equal footing. My vision is clear: capacity development. Acknowledging the privilege of working in DWARS, a political youth organisation with a history of more than 30 years and a comprehensive expanding institutional and organisational framework, many of our sibling organisations are, simply put, much newer and less experienced. As board member, my core focus will be utilising my experience in capacity and organisational development to build a framework in which the organisations with the most capacity have an avenue of sharing their skills, knowledge and experience with those that have the least. And it is my pragmatism and record in which I ensure campaign promises aren't simply empty platitudes.

Solidarity within the board entails working as a team. I am always willing to listen and work together, coming to a compromise when needed without letting go of my own ideals. My priority as a member of a team is not only a healthy productive dynamic internally, but the bonds built together externally, outside work. (Also, I love cooking, and cook well!)

Thus, as someone with a vision, a mission, and the ignition to bring this into fruition, my addition to the Federation is *the* pragmatic choice to truly make the Federation a federation of young European greens.

Vision on FYEG

Continuing off of my motivation letter, I will aim for concision – outlining in detail the precise plans I have as a member of the board. My vision for my term as board member can be separated into three spheres wherein solidarity stands central: within the Federation, within the internal organisation, and external to the Federation.

Capacity development

As aforementioned, capacity development is at the heart of my plans. Within the Federation, ensuring that every member organisation has a solid foundation is core to the long-term blossoming of the Federation. I've listened to our fellow young greens, of conflicts with their parent party, of issues with funding, with expansion, retention, internal policies, inclusion, of inexperience with internal organisation and structure. If we want to strive for a Europe that lives up to the principles of solidarity and fair sharing of responsibility, we have to start at home. This must be striven for not solely supranationally from the Federation, but coordinated internationally by the Federation between our member organisations.

Supranationally, I aim to continue and further strengthen the efforts of the Federation in this regard, taking inspiration from my work in the Dutch context, and first and foremost prioritising the internal organisation and policies crucial to laying the foundation of a political (youth) organisation. This entails the formulation and compilation of guidelines and templates to internal policies in conjunction with the relevant working groups and experienced member organisations, including but not limited to statutes, by-laws, diversity and inclusivity policies, integrity policies, recruitment policies, privacy policies, and codes of conduct; and catering them based on the needs and deficiencies of each member organisation that could make use of it.

Internationally, I aim to build a framework in which the Federation coordinates connecting member organisations with the most experience or expertise in a specific organisational area with member organisations with less capacity or who are in need of help in that regard. I envision the willing cooperation of the member organisations with the most capacity in striving for this solidarity and making this successful.

Intersectional inclusion

The internal organisation of the Federation itself is as much a priority. An opinion I have oft-shared is that being part of a green movement unfortunately tends to be an option solely available to the privileged, on a macro-level to the West, and on a micro-level to the predominantly White, predominantly academia, and predominantly urban.

The work done up until now by the Federation to be an inclusive, radical feminist organisation is commendable if not inspirational. I can only hope to further this, expanding on the internal rules of procedure as well as taking the next steps to update the Inclusion Plan 2019-2021. There will be a particular focus on the inclusion of POC and those of minority national, cultural or ethnic origins or backgrounds – and working on a strategy on how we could ensure that they too feel included within the green and left movement. Intersectionality will not solely be a “lens” through which we look at, but the very core and rationale in which we carry out our work.

International solidarity

It is vital to recognise the privileged position the Federation has. Externally, capacity development is just as relevant, and the sharing of resources – information and expertise – with our sibling organisations throughout the world is crucial. There will especially be a focus on the Asian region, cultures and peoples, as there is a considerable absence of the Asian voice within social justice and international political discourse – one made increasingly clear during the COVID-19 pandemic. Holding the concepts of corrective and distributive justice at heart, I will ensure any policy or issue we push vis-à-vis a nation of the global south reconciles the imperial past and present of Europe.

Let us strive for a Federation that realises solidarity, diversity, inclusivity, and intersectionality in all aspects, together.
