From line 418 to 419:

Two thirds Three-quarters of the Executive Committee can propose dismissal of an Executive Committee member.

From line 439 to 441:

Secretary-General, the Secretary-General is dismissed. The Executive Committee can propose dismissal of the Secretary General, with two-thirdsthree-quarters of the votes of the members of the EC. The Member Organisations must be notified within 8 days

Reason

in a body of 8 ppl, 2/3 = 5.33, which needs to be rounded up to 6 in order to be a 2/3 majority. the suggestion is to change it to a 3/4 majority, because in an 8 ppl body $\frac{3}{4}$ = 6

? it's "just" a technicality, but it creates more clarity and helps to avoid ambiguity in the future.
