in case of by-election, the term only counts as a mandate if it exceeds 69 months

Reason

We believe the EC's suggestion of 6 months is too little. thinking of the scenario of a by election 6.5 or 7 months before the next regular election at a ga, the person by-elected could only spend one quarter (or a wee bit more) of the time in the EC compared to the time of 2 years the regularly elected EC members have to act and implement plans and policies. nevertheless the 6.5 or 7 months of the by-elected person would count as a full mandate. we believe it is much fairer to set the threshold for a mandate at 9 months.
