MY MOTIVATION



My first prep team. Strasbourg, 2019. Just a few months after the last European election.

It has been the pleasure of a lifetime to serve FYEG for the last year and I am hungry for more. Our impact is growing, and we need to make it count this year like no other.

A year ago, I stood for election arguing that we needed three things:

First, I argued we needed to empower people within FYEG. One year later, I see that this is what we're doing. Our applications for events and prep teams are at record levels, which is evidence of the success of our work to steadily deepen the engagement of our activists. This has also contributed to the unplanned launching of two new working groups - the racial justice taskforce and the Beyond Growth Platform. (Here, a special thanks has to go to Srish, for leading the launch of these projects in tandem with a small number of highly committed activists.) I have personally worked to support the bottom-up projects of member organisations, which bode well for the growth of FYEG's power in the coming years.

Second, I said that we need to have a more visibility active EC, which was the political face of the Federation. I am immensely proud of the progress we have made in this, and the feedback that I get from member organisations leaves me little doubt that this has been an area that we have excelled in as an EC - in collaboration with the office, as always.

Finally, I argued we needed to bring FYEG closer to our MOs. And this is exactly what we've done. I have travelled around Europe visiting member organisations, and I hope the next EC as a whole will visit even more. We organised the Young Greens Decentralised Training, in which expert trainers upskilled our MOs in key fundamentals of their organisations. Next year, I'm keen for us to include more include more antiracism training in this work. In general, I'm proud to see that the organisation has grown in this regard.

In short, I'm proud of what we have achieved.

And now I look to the future. While the Young European Greens grow, civic space is shrinking in much of Europe. While we talk of our dreams, the futures of our comrades in Ukraine are taken. But I do see immense potential for what we can achieve. I see that while the European election has potential for disaster, it also has potential for positive transformation. But that can only happen if organisation like FYEG are organised, strategic, and at the top of our game for the next 13 months.

I know I can help FYEG to be that organisation, and I am excited to help that happen. I hope you will join us along the way.

MY VISION

This year, we're going big.

In a time of overlapping crises and an emboldened far-right, there is only one answer: to stand up and fight back. This European election, we plan to do a targeted mobilisation campaign that is bigger than any European organisation has done before for an EU election. At the same time, we will aim for a repeat success of the Young Candidates' Platform - upskilling candidates and helping them to get elected.

But what else?

As a federation that exists to influence European politics (at the European, national and local levels), I am keen for expanding the work of FYEG to influence what happens in the European institutions. We've made a great start this year with initiatives like the Youth Assembly, and we have a strong

connection to both social movements on the one hand and powerful actors like Young Green MEPs on the other. This is exactly the year we need to continue this progress, and work to make tangible gains in the politics of the European institutions.

None of this works without you. Our election and our broader strategy of influence are reliant on our mobilising young activists to take action. We know that we can achieve huge things this year, even bigger than four years ago, and to do so we will need to work hard to engage activists in doing the work that excites them and that they find most impactful. We have already made great real-world progress on this supported by structural work like the development of a CRM software. Now is the time to put it into action.

Our MOs are our greatest strength. That is why, this year, we will once again roll out the successful training for MOs that Cinta and Srish led last year. They have helped us to develop our learnings and this year we will do it even better. In my other life I am also a freelance trainer, so I'm excited to support this work which will once again be focused on our non-EU MOs.

This vision statement can only scratch the surface of what we have planned for this game-changing year in European politics. This GA will be a launchpad for what is to come, and we need you to get involved in what comes next. Our future is at stake, let's fucking win it.
