R3 A27: Resolution for Peace and Justice in Palestine and Israel

Motion text

From line 103 to 109:

- Recognise the right of Palestinian and Israeli people to self-determination, and reaffirm support for a two-state solution based on secure and mutually agreed borders on 1967 lines.
- Implement a comprehensive arms embargo on Israel, including the prohibition of both the sale and purchase of weapons and military equipment, and immediately halt all military collaboration with Israel.
- Recognise the state of Palestine, with its capital in Jerusalem, and welcome it into the UN.
- Terminate the EU-Israel Association Agreement due to grave and systematic violations of Article 2, which concerns human rights and democratic principles.
- Condemn the criminalisation and police violence against Palestine protestors in Europe.
- Impose targeted sanctions on Israeli leadership figures, individuals and entities implicated in the commission of war crimes, crimes against humanity, or human right abuses. Such sanctions can include travel bans, asset freezes, and restrictions on financial transactions.

From line 112 to 118:

- Ensure Israel abides by Article 2 of the EU-Israel association agreement, respecting human rights and democratic principles.
- Promote divestment from companies supporting human rights abuses or war crimes.
- Prohibit the import of all Israeli goods and services from the occupied Occupied Palestinian territories.
- Terminate all EU and European Central Bank (ECB) funding, loans, and financial support to Israel, including grants, research and development funding, and participation in programs such as Horizon Europe.
- <u>Pursue the expulsion of Israel from the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).</u>
- End the sale and export of weapons to Israel.
- Conduct a comprehensive assessment of all diplomatic, political, economic, and cultural relations with Israel, with a view toward suspension or termination where appropriate.
- Promote divestment from companies supporting human rights abuses or war crimes.
- Promote Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) against individuals and institutions that support or facilitate Israel's occupation of Palestine, including participation in sporting and cultural events.
- Recognise the right of Palestinian people to self-determination, and reaffirm support for a two-state solution based on secure and mutually agreed borders on 1967 lines.
- Recognise the state of Palestine, with its capital in Jerusalem, and welcome it into the UN.
- Condemn the criminalisation and police violence against Palestine protestors in Europe.

We believe that by this addition to the text we tackle the problem of investment to Israel made by the West and propose a clear disenvestment plan and sanctioning of the individuals resposnible for the ongoing genocide in Gaza.
