Motion text

From line 170 to 172:

The call for hosting the General Assembly must be sent ~~out by latest 1st of October~~ as soon as possible, no later than 7 months before the tentative dates of every year ~~with a one month deadline~~ the GA. The call must be open at least one month. The selection of the hosting organisation is done by the Executive Committee.

Insert in line 176:

Registration of all participants
delegates

Delete from line 183 to 186:

~~10 weeks before the General Assembly:
The Executive Committee must also organise an online information session, explaining the functioning of the General Assembly and promoting the different open positions.~~

Insert after line 188:

Between 10 and 7 weeks before the GA
The Executive Committee must also organise an online information session, explaining the functioning of the General Assembly and promoting the different open positions.

In line 217:

~~publication of~~ MOs to express their support for candidates

In line 219:

amendments to the resolutions, ~~Activity Plan~~ and ~~Financial Plan~~ Plans

Reason

These amendments on the GA deadlines aim to have our IRPs allowing for more flexibility and better describe the GA process. This is the explanation for each change:

- on the call for host organisation: the EC suggests to focus on the period of time, rather than on the specific date, in case of for example eventual change
- ~~On the call for GA~~ Participants: the changes clarify that the registration is for all participants (not only delegates), and adds the delegates separately to
- ~~On the information session~~ it is suggested to give more flexibility to the EC to
- ~~On the MO support to candidates~~ the wording is changed to reflect the current process, by which the MOs do not send letters, but express the support
- ~~On the submission of amendments~~: as there is sometimes more Plans tabled in the GAs other than the Financial and the Activity Plan, this wording reflects better that all Plans are up for being amended.
