This</u> <u>means recognising the care nature provides and fostering practices of care in return,</u> <u>through environmental education and connection to local nature in schools, accessible</u> <u>green spaces in cities, the protection of these spaces from green gentrification, and</u> <u>community initiatives that promote respectful, balanced interactions with more-than-human</u> <u>life.</u>

Reason

In line with the amendment proposed by GEV on a call for education campaigns, we find it important to grant a right of access to nature alongside fostering more caring practices, and at the same time ensuring that nature is accessible to all.
