General Assembly is presided in line with the Meeting Rules (Annex - 1). The Executive Committee can propose additions for the Meeting Rules no later than a week before the General Assembly. These additions must be sent to all member organizations, and they must be approved at the start of the General Assembly by a simple majority and they lose power once the General Assembly is concluded.

Reason

Since the Meeting Rules are set in the IRPs, we have had many extraordinary examples of precedents present at our General Assemblies, to name a few - who is allowed in the pre-voting discussion, how does the speaking list work, etc. With this amendment, we are aiming to resolve some precedents for the upcoming General Assembly without changing the IRPs every year to address them. These additions could be prepared in collaboration with the proposed presidency. The EC wants to stress that, if adopted, these changes will take effect starting the next General Assembly, and only then the Executive Committee may propose these additions to the Meeting Rules.
