In this context, FYEG strongly opposes the organisation of large-scale events such as the Winter Olympics in the Alpine region, whether in Italy (2026) or in France (2030). These events require unsustainable infrastructure developments, promote short-term mass tourism, and contradict the principles of climate responsibility and social justice. The Alps must not be used as a setting for projects that prioritise visibility and profit over environmental protection and the well-being of local communities.
