We condemn the ongoing failure of European nations to take sufficient action on the climate crisis, as demonstrated and confirmed by the European Court of Human Rights in the landmark case of the KlimaSenior*innen of Switzerland.

The failure of prevention and protection first and foremost endangers the most vulnerable, the elderly, the disabled, as well as FINTA* and the inhabitants of more rural environments, especially, but not solemnly, in the Mediterranean basin.

Demands:

The continuous condemnation of the insufficient action of the European nations regarding the climate crisis through the European Court of Human Rights as seen in the landmark case of the KlimaSenior*innen of Switzerland.

Full compliance of European nations with the rulings of the European Court of Human Rights regarding the insufficient prevention of the climate crisis and the protection of the most vulnerable, as well as the immediate implementation of demanded measures by the European Court of Human Rights.
