Insert from line 977 to 979:

If the compromise is disputed, the compromise will be sought until the last day of the General Assembly. If no compromise is agreed upon by the final voting session (as determined by the Presidency at the GA's commencement), amendments will be voted on as submitted. If the Resolution proposer and Amendment proposer agree on a compromise, but a Full Member Organisation or the Executive Committee objects, the General Assembly will vote by simple majority to determine whether the compromised version or original version of the amendment is voted on. It is encouraged that the CAS sessions are organised in advance of the General Assembly, following the deadline for amendments which is

Reason

This amendment seeks to clarify the process around Compromise Amendment Sessions, and to make clear what course of action should be followed if no compromise can be achieved on the final day which is amenable to all parties. This is a circumstance where the IRPs are otherwise quite vague, and a clear structure for managing uncompromised disagreements will help with the smooth running of future GAs.
