### **Motion text**

Imperialism disproportionately harms marginalised communities, including women, racialised groups, LGBTQIA+ people, migrants, and young people, while concentrating power in the hands of states and corporations. Imperial violence reinforces patriarchal systems through militarisation, sexual violence, economic precarity, and attacks on bodily autonomy. Climate breakdown, forced displacement, militarisation, and economic exploitation are interconnected consequences of the same extractivist system. The urgency to act is therefore both global and European.

### **Reason**

This amendment makes clearer how imperialism affects different marginalised groups and strengthens the feminist and intersectional analysis of the text. It explicitly recognises the impact on LGBTQIA+ people and migrants, while also showing how imperial violence reinforces patriarchy through militarisation, sexual violence, and attacks on bodily autonomy. This gives a more complete picture of the systems imperialism upholds.
