Amendments 3-4-5-6 Concerning Awareness Team Reform and Safe Space
Policy**

Motion text

1 **Noting that**

- 2 • The Executive Committee is undertaking a broader reform of FYEG’s
3 Awareness Team, safe space framework, and internal accountability
4 structures;
- 5 • Existing procedural gaps, outdated governance provisions, and previous
6 misinterpretations of the Internal Rules of Procedure have limited the
7 democratic legitimacy, transparency, and practical effectiveness of these
8 structures;

9 **Recognising that**

- 10 • The reform package aims to strengthen the role of the General Assembly in
11 approving and overseeing the volunteer member of the Awareness Team;
- 12 • Safer space and safeguarding procedures must remain effective,
13 participatory, and immediately enforceable to ensure trust,
14 accountability, and survivor protection;.
- 15 • Delays in implementation could undermine the coherence and effectiveness
16 of these urgently needed governance reforms;

17 **Believing that**

- 18 • The immediate enforcement of amendments 3, 4, 5, and 6 is necessary to
19 ensure full practical application of the Executive Committee’s awareness
20 and safe space reform agenda;

21 • These amendments collectively improve democratic oversight, transparency,
22 procedural clarity, and safeguarding flexibility across FYEG's governance
23 framework;

24 • Immediate implementation ensures consistency between the Statutes, IRPs,
25 and the broader institutional reform process;

26 **The Executive Committee requests, with the**
27 **approval of**
28 **the General Assembly, that**

29 • IRP amendments 3, 4, 5, and 6 be applied immediately upon adoption;

30 **Note:** As the Statutes and IRPs are being amended, this resolution shall, where
31 necessary, be interpreted in line with any adopted changes to ensure coherence
32 throughout FYEG's governance framework.
